

School Uniform

Student must wear prescribed School uniform every day. The student without proper School uniform shall not be allowed to attend classes. For wing-wise and season-wise uniform of the students, parents are required to contact the School office.

Fee Schedule

- Admission fee has to be paid at the time of Admission.
- Tuition Fee is to be paid separately either Monthly/ Quarterly/Half yearly/Annually.
- Transport charges are to be paid on Monthly basis.
- Examination Fee is to be paid separately.
- Annual Misc. Charge is to be paid at the beginning of a new session.
- No exemption/deduction in fees will be made on account of broken period/holidays or absence from the class.
- No student will be allowed to appear at the examination unless all his/her dues are cleared.
- Non payment of fees for two consecutive months will lead to automatic removal and cancellation of admission from school








- All students are expected to attend school on all school working days.
- No leave of absence is granted except on a written application from parent or guardian for a valid reason only.
- A minimum of 80% of the total attendance in an Academic session would be necessary for the Final Examination and
- Parents are requested to ensures that their children arrive and leave the school punctually.
- Student must not bring mobile phones, walkmans or any similar gadgets to school.
- All students are expected to speak strictly in English only.
- Escort Identity cards issued by the school are necessary for all parents to pick up the child from school.
- If a parent expects the child to go back home on his/her own, they will have to submit an undertaking about the same.
- No child will be handed over to a person not known to the school authorities/security. In case of another person coming to pick up the child, the substitute is expected to have both Escort Identity Card and a letter of authority.
- Parents/Guardians are requested to come on time to pick up
- The school reserves the right to make changes in the school rules.
